



TAX CUTS PLEDGE

In December of 2017 Congress passed the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act, the largest tax cut in history, and the most important tax relief in decades for small businesses. The measure passed along strict party lines, despite that every American in every tax bracket received a tax cut. Since the enactment of the law, employers of every size have given pay raises, bonuses and expanded benefits to millions of American workers. Major companies with operations over seas have announced major new investments in the United States.
