

BIDEN'S CLAIMS VS. REALITY

AMERICANS CAN'T AFFORD FOUR MORE YEARS OF FAILED POLICIES



BIDEN CLAIM: → REALITY:

“Wages are up, and they’re growing faster than inflation.”
— **Speech, 1/26/23**

Real wages have declined for two straight years as historic inflation has outpaced nominal wage increases.

“We have created a record 12 million new jobs, more jobs created in two years than any president has ever created in four years.”
— **State of the Union, 2/7/23**

Biden has added about 3 million jobs, far from a presidential record. The other roughly 9 million jobs that Biden is attempting to take credit for were merely backfilled positions that were regained post-pandemic.

“[Inflation] was already there when I got here, man.”
— **Press Conference, 2/3/23**

When Biden first became president, inflation was only 1.4%.

“We cut the debt by \$1.7 trillion the last two years.”
— **Speech, 2/15/23**

The debt has increased by about \$3.7 trillion during Biden’s time as president, rising to about \$31.5 trillion.
